

Simplified Steps to Use Your Member Portal

Go to navitus.com/members or scan the QR code* to access the member portal. [Register](#) for your account, if you haven't already done so.

If you have the Navitus mobile app, you can log into the Navitus member portal with the same username and password you created for the app. There is no need to register again.



Once registered, click [Sign In](#), then enter your login details and password. From here you can:

- Access your member ID card
- Perform a Drug Search for coverage details
- Find drug prices and pharmacy locations
- Easily track your medication history

Access Your Member ID Card

From the landing page, click [View now](#) to see a digital copy of your Member ID card. You can also [Save as PDF](#) and print your card.

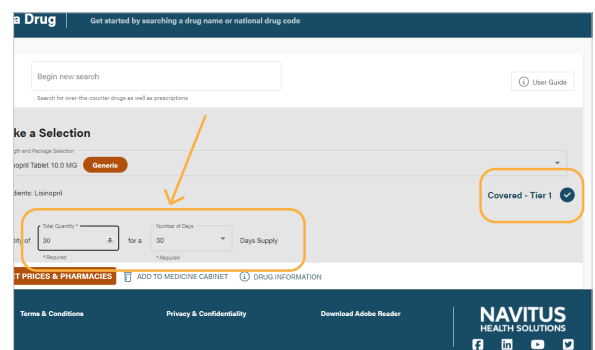
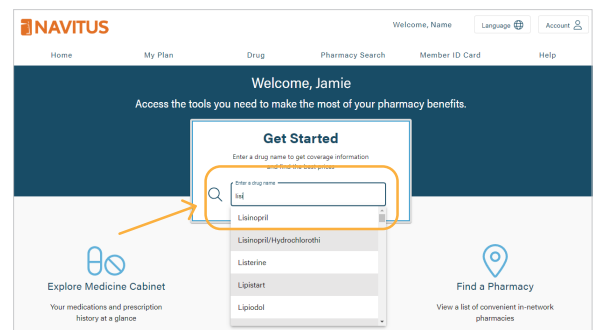
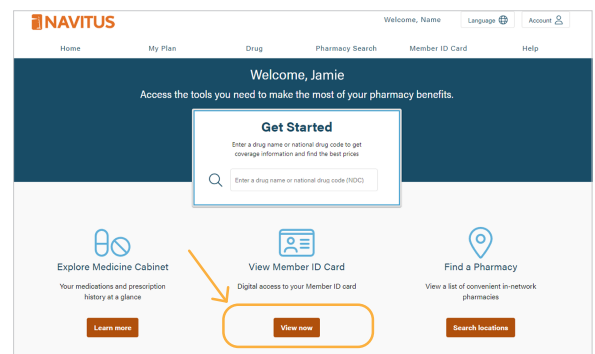
Perform a Drug Search

From the landing page, enter at least the first letter of the drug name in the [Get Started](#) search box. Click on the specific drug name from the dropdown menu of search suggestions.

You will be prompted to [Make a Selection](#).

- Click on the down arrow for a refined list.
- Select the dosage form, strength and brand or generic designation you need.
- Adjust the [Total Quantity](#) and [Number of Days](#) for that supply.

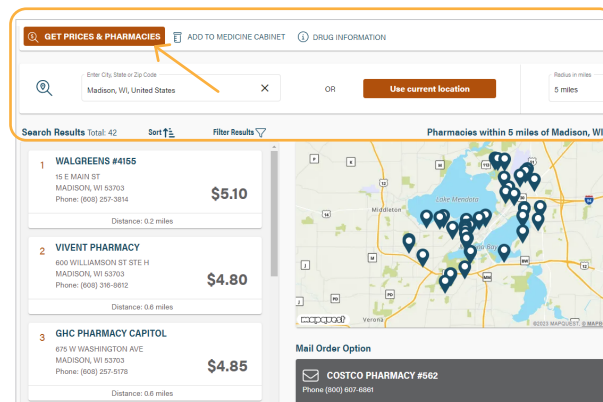
The coverage indicator uses these details to show whether the medication is covered under your plan and at what tier, helping you make an informed decision.



Find Drug Prices and Pharmacy Locations

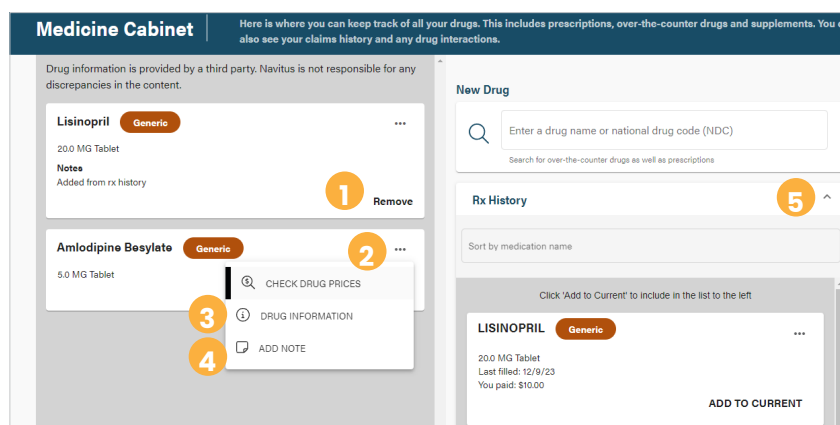
From the Drug Search result, click [Get Prices & Pharmacies](#). Search by city, state, zip code or current location and adjust the search radius, if needed. A list of available pharmacies, the price of the drug at that location, and an interactive map will appear.

- Refine your search with [Sort](#) and [Filter Results](#) options.
- Click on a pharmacy for more details, including hours and additional services provided.
- Click [Add to Favorites](#) to save this pharmacy selection to your member profile.
- You can also search for pharmacy locations from the member portal homepage, but those results will not include specific drug coverage details.



Maintain Your Virtual Medicine Cabinet

Click [Learn more](#) under [Explore Medicine Cabinet](#) to see your prescription, medication and supplement history. Your prescriber doesn't maintain this list, but you can use it to conveniently track your drugs and check side effects.

4. Need to leave a note for yourself about a medication? Click the three dots to open a new menu. Click [Add Note](#).
5. Want to add a prescription? Click the drop-down menu for Rx History.
